4. When a boy comes to camp from a home that is undergoing change (new location, new school, separation, etc) his experience and adjustment is often affected. Are any of these changes a part of your son's life, and if so how is he adapting?
5. What do you particularly wish your son to gain from his experience at Night Eagle Wilderness Adventures?
